Auslan Storytime: Equal Access for Deaf Children

One of the programs you're supporting is Auslan Storytime – bringing the magic of sign language storytelling to life.

We all know that early literacy development for little learners is critical. But one issue some Deaf children face is limited access to programs and events that use Auslan. While many children use hearing devices, these don't provide full access to sound in all environments. Without opportunities to engage with sign language, Deaf children may experience increased listening fatigue or feel excluded from learning experiences.

Auslan Storytime is a great way to get access to literacy through Auslan and English. Led by a Deaf presenter and accompanied by an Auslan Interpreter, the program brings stories to life through the beauty of sign language. Each session creates a bilingual space where everyone can learn and participate, whether they're Deaf or hearing. Our organisation has proudly partnered with several libraries across Queensland, New South Wales, the Northern Territory, and Western Australia to deliver more of these sessions across the country.

Deaf Connect's General Manager for Community and Capacity, Andrew Wiltshire, explained what makes Auslan Storytime so important: "These sessions give Deaf and hardof-hearing children the chance to see
a Deaf role model, while supporting the
development of their early literacy and
communication skills. Library story times
are incredibly popular for young families.
Auslan Storytime offers that same joy, but
in a space where Deaf kids can belong and
build friendships with one another."

"The majority of Deaf children are born into hearing families, so these sessions are also an opportunity for families to meet others who've had similar experiences, and build their connections to the Deaf community. Learning Auslan together strengthens family bonding and creates a sense of belonging for everyone."
